Small = +70mm to 90mm;

Medium = +90mm to 110mm;

Large = +110mm to 130mm;

Very Large = over 130mm.

Subject for Section 2: "The Camellia in the Garden Landscape" (*Please include the camellia name, if known.*)

Class 1: Photograph 6" X 4" (150mm X 100mm)

Class 2: Photograph Any size above 6" X 4" (15cm X 10cm) and up to A4 (29.7cm X 21cm)

Conditions of Entry

1. Entry is free
2. All entries should be received by post by or hand by 1st July, 2017 and sent to "Art Competition", 2 Narelle Ave Pymble 2073. (Allow 6 days)
3. Entries will not be accepted on the day.
4. All entries above 6"X4" size are to be presented with a mounting surround of 2cm.
5. All photographs have to have been taken in 2016-2017.
6. All entries will be displayed at the Annual Camellia Show 2017.
7. All photographs are to be collected at 4pm on Sunday 9th July at the show unless they have included a suitable stamped self-addressed envelope.

Conditions of Entry for All Exhibitors in Bloom Competition

1. Entries are free, and are open to all.
2. The hall will be open at **7am** and entries will be accepted up to **11am on Saturday**, when all persons except judges & stewards must leave the competitive areas to facilitate judging.
3. Containers are provided for all classes and must be used.
4. Individual blooms in Sections A-I should have no more than two (2) leaves and no buds.
5. Named cultivars include their sports and variegated forms, unless these are listed separately.
6. **Exhibitors' name cards are available from Show Stewards**, or may be made at home from **white cardboard**
 - 6.1. Cards should measure approx 7cm x 2.5cm. One card is to be placed in front of each entry with the exhibitor's name face down. For named classes the upper side of the card should remain blank.
 - 6.2. For unnamed classes the upper side is to show correct cultivar or species name (except Sections K and L)
7. Not more than two (2) entries per exhibitor are permitted in classes for named cultivars. In other classes entries are restricted to two (2) per cultivar per exhibitor.
8. Gibbed blooms are not permitted.
9. Spraying of exhibits on the show bench is prohibited.
10. Use of artificial aids is prohibited in Sections A-I, except for inconspicuously securing a bloom to its original foliage by pin or wire
11. Interfering with or moving other exhibitors' entries is prohibited. Only Show Stewards are permitted to move exhibits to provide space, ensure blooms are entered in the correct classes, or to check compliance with conditions of entry. Breach of the conditions of entry may result in disqualification of an exhibitor's entry or entries, at the discretion of the Show Stewards.
12. Certificates/ribbons and all Awards are to remain on the tables until closure of the Show at 4pm Sunday, and exhibitors must collect them before 5.30pm on that day, unless special arrangements have been made with the Show Manager.
13. All exhibits will be judged according to the standards and rules of the NSW Camellia Research Society Inc, and the decision of the judges will be final.
14. **Individual Form Champion blooms will be selected from Sections A to G only.**
15. All exhibits remain the property of the Society.
16. All entries must be from the exhibitor's own plants, owned for at least 3 months.
17. Judges may exhibit in all sections, but are expected to use discretion when judging.
18. Camellias not registered, or commercially or widely distributed, are only eligible in Section K.
19. **Awards:**
 - 19.1. **Certificates** for 1st and 2nd place in all classes, and Commended seedlings in Section K, will be awarded at the judges' discretion, in each class.
 - 19.2. **Champion Sashes** will be awarded for **Champion Camellia of the Show**; each of the **5 Form Champions – Single; Semi-double/Irregular Semi-double; Elegans Form; Informal Double; Formal Double** and **Champion Collection**.
20. **Points** will be allotted as follows
 - 5 points** - Champion Collection & Champion Camellia of the Show;
 - 4 points** - Individual Champion Blooms
 - 3 points** - each 1st place in Section I classes (Collections)
 - 2 points** - each 1st place in Sections A - H classes and each 2nd place in Section I classes (Collections)
 - 1 point** - each 2nd place in Sections A – H classes
21. **Prizes – Cultural Classes (Sections A – I):**
 - 21.1. **Champion Prizes** will be awarded to the Champion Camellia of Show, the other Form Champions and the Champion Collection.
 - 21.2. **Point Score competition:** Several places will be awarded prizes **donated by Eden Gardens, Organic Crop Protectants, Hargraves Nurseryland, Yates, and Neutrog Fertilizers**
 - 21.3. **Australian Raised Cultivar Prize** donated by R & G O'Connor, for a bloom in Section A otherwise un-awarded
 - 21.4. **Beth Bond Memorial Prize** donated by Lindsay Bond, for Best Winter's Own Variegated (class 155).
 - 21.5. **Barry Di Salvia Trophy** donated by Kate and Paul Stanley for Best Species Bloom in Show
 - 21.6. **Higo Prize** donated by Elizabeth & Chris Navin for the Best Higo otherwise un-awarded
 - 21.7. **Lindsay Bond Prize** donated by Lindsay Bond for the Best Reticulata otherwise un-awarded
 - 21.8. **Lucy Payens Prize**, for Best Exhibit in Section H – Clusters and Sprays
 - 21.9. **Miniature Prize**, donated by Elizabeth Navin for the Best Miniature otherwise un-awarded
 - 21.10. **Murray Moyes Memorial Prize**, donated by the Moyes family, for a bloom exhibited in Class 9, 23, 24, 25 or 26
 - 21.11. **President's Prize**, donated by Wendy Sadler-Moyes for a bloom exhibited in Section L
